Your child will need to bring lunch or money so they can buy lunch. We supply fruit and biscuits for morning and afternoon tea. If going on the trip, lunch must be pre-packed, and a drink must also be included. A hat, rain jacket and suitable, warm clothing must be supplied so these can be worn outside or taken on trips (all items should be named).

We will use Glenfield Primary School facilities for soccer, cricket, basketball, baseball, hand ball, DVD'S, Wii games and movies etc. We also have art and craft activities set up daily. Feel free to bring your bike, blades or scooters **but skateboarding is not permitted at Glenfield Primary School.**

NB. Children's own helmets must be worn on bikes and scooters. Please adjust these prior to attending so that they fit properly.
